ABOUT ADVOCATE4ENVIRONMENT





The Advocate4Environment project aims to promote the participation of young people in volunteer work and advocacy on environmental issues. The project intends to achieve this goal by developing educational materials that give insight to the history of environmental advocacy, thus providing young people and youth workers with sources for inspiration and the tools to develop new forms of advocacy.

Advocate4Environment was funded with the **support of the Erasmus+ Programme.** The project is being developed by a team of five organisations from Denmark, Portugal, Sweden, Ireland and Slovenia as follows:

- Rightchallenge (Portugal)
- Region Örebro County (Sweden)
- Future in Perspective Ltd (Ireland)
- Association for Developing Voluntary Work Novo mesto (Slovenia)













The Advocate4Environment project team has completed the development of an Environmental Education and Advocacy Curriculum (IO1), which aims to provide young people with the learning and tools they need to take action and become advocates for environmental protection and the fight against climate change.

II. ADVOCACY

The Curriculum has been developed so that it can be used both in groups and individually with activities in face-to-face or online formats. It is available on the website for download in English, Danish, Slovenian, Swedish and Portuguese.



NEXT STEPS



The Advocate4Environment team is developing a handbook that aims to raise awareness of the impact of activism as a means to strengthen youth participation and the importance of example-driven leadership through advocacy.

The target group for the handbook are practitioners or volunteers working with young people. The handbook will contain information and tools to develop and implement an awareness raising strategy and introduce the concept of activism and advocacy to young people via online.
