Environmental Education and Advocacy

Curriculum (IO1) - aims to promote the understanding of concepts related to the environment and sustainability. Thus, it seeks the development of conscious and critical individuals by strengthening advocacy practices. The developed curriculum is available in all partners languages at the project website. During the project the curriculum has also been applied in group and individual learning settings – either in face-to-face or online learning environments.

Handbook (IO2) - aims to foster the understanding of the impact of advocacy as a means to empower youth participation and the importance of example-driven leadership through advocacy. The main target groups of the handbook are professionals or volunteers working with youth. This handbook is fully available in all partner languages in the project website.
